- VI. METHOD OF PARTICIPATION
- 1. Participants:

The number of participants and entries is unlimited.

- 2. Categories for age
- a) Speed Skating

- 1) Senior: Born on or before December 31st, 1997
- 2) Junior: Born between January 1st, 1998 and December 31st, 1999
- 3) Youth A: Born between January 1st, 2000 and December 31st, 2001
- 4) Youth B: Born between January 1st, 2002 and December 31st, 2003
- 5) Youth C: Born between January 1st, 2004 and December 31st, 2005
- 6) Youth D: Born between January 1st, 2006 and December 31st, 2007
- b) Artistic Skating
 - 1) Senior: Born on or before December 31st, 1998
 - 2) Junior: Born between January 1st, 1999 and December 31st, 2002
 - 3) Youth: Born between January 1st, 2002 and January 1st, 2005
- c) Freestyle Skating
 - 1) Senior: Born on or before December 31st, 1998
 - 2) Junior: Born on or after January 1st, 1999
- 3. The age of each athlete will be checked against his/her passport or ID card before the competition.

VII.COMPETITION METHOD

- 1. The latest version of CIC, CIPA, CIRILH, CIRH and WSSA rules shall be applied in the competition.
- 2. Music for Artistic Skating must be on separate CD and be collected by the Judge Committee while confirming the final entries ONE day prior to the commencement of the competitions. These CDs must be clearly marked with the skaters' names, sex, country/region, category and event. No other music shall be recorded in the CD.
- 3. Music for Freestyle Skating must be sent to aic_event@163.com before August 10th, 2015. The music must be recorded by MP3 format and clearly marked with the skaters' delegation, name, category and event.
- 4. Inline Marathon Skating
 - a) Time limited:

1) Full Distance: 150 min

2) Half Distance: 75 min

3) Mini Distance: 50 min

b) Electronic Chronometer will be used in Full and half distance.

5. It is a must for all athletes from the same team to wear the uniform garments to attend the marching-in ceremony and take part in all competitions.

6. All skating equipment should be adequate for the safety of the competition.

VIII. RANKING & AWARDING

- 1. The top 6 (six) places of each category will be awarded. The top 3 (three) places will be awarded medals and certificate, the 4th to 6th places will be awarded certificates.
- 2. If the participation is 6 (six) persons / teams, the top 5 (five) places will be awarded; if the participation is 5 (five) persons / teams, the top 4 (four) places will be awarded; and so on.
- 3. If the participation of group is 3 (three) or less than 3 (three) participants, the event shall be cancelled.
- 4. The participants ranked after 6th place will be awarded participant certificate.
