SKATING DISCIPLINES

FREESTYLE SLALOM CLASSIC:

The skaters have to perform a run from 105sec. to 120sec. with the music of their choice using 3 lines of cones each spaced of 50cm; 80cm; 120cm. The skaters are judged on their technical and artistic performance.

PAIR FREESTYLE SLALOM: (To be confirmed)

Teams of 2 skaters have to perform a run from 160sec. to 180sec. with the music of their choice using 3 lines of cones each spaced of 50cm; 80cm; 120cm. The skaters are judged on their technical and artistic performance but also on synchronization.

FREESTYLE SLALOM BATTLE:

The skaters have to perform 2 to 3 runs of 30sec. each, in groups of 3 to 4 skaters in order to qualify from the first round to the final. The skaters are judged on their technical skills.

SPEED SLALOM:

The skaters have to go as fast as possible through a line of 20 cones placed at 80cm intervals. They have to qualify individually during the time trials. The final is in a 1 versus 1 KO system.

FREESTYLE SLIDES:

The skaters have to perform 4 to 5 slides/runs each, in groups of 3 to 5 skaters in order to qualify from the first round to the final. The skaters are judged on their technical skills and the length of the slides.

FREEJUMP:

The skaters have 2 tries to jump over a stick placed higher and higher starting at 80cm.

Freestyle Slides: Men, Ladies

Pair Slalom: Teams of two skaters (to be confirmed)

Freejump: Men, Ladies (to be confirmed)

METHOD OF PARTICIPATION

WSSA affiliated associations can present a team to represent a country. Independent skaters are also invited to register.

Green Card: This is only applicable to skaters who are in the WSSA World Top 20 ranking. The Top 20 skaters have the priority to represent their country in participating to PSWC.

Skaters:

Limited quantities of skaters will be announced according to the registrations.

AGE GROUPS (ELIGIBILITY)

Speed Slalom, Freestyle Slalom and Classic:

Juniors: born between January 1st 2000 (included) and before 31st December 2006

Seniors: born before 31st December 1999 (included)

A skater whose birthdate would place him in the junior category is not allowed to participate in the senior categories.

Pair Slalom: not classified by age or sex categories.

Slides: not classified by age categories.

Freejump: not classified by age categories.

The organization will check all the athletes' passports or ID during the registration process, in order to validate the category of each skater, and will confirm the categories during the registrations.

COMPETITION METHOD

The most updated articles of the WSSA Freestyle Skating Rules shall be applied. Skates, pads and other equipment should be adequate for the safety of skaters.

The music for Freestyle Slalom Classic and Pair Freestyle Slalom must be in MP3 format and must be submitted to the organizer by email as informed on the website. Failing to do so, the local organizer reserves the right not to accept late submission and cancel participation.

RANKING AND AWARDING

The top 6 of each category will be awarded.

The top 3 of each category will be awarded with trophies and certificates.

The 4th to 6th places will be awarded only with certificates.

If a category only contains 3 countries or less the event shall be counted only as a demonstration event and no certificate should be awarded.
